**AGREED ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION
TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

This case came before the Court on the Unopposed Motion to Determine the Confidentiality of Court Records (the “Motion”) filed by Plaintiff, Baptist Health System, Inc. (“Baptist”) on June 12, 2026. The Court, having reviewed the unopposed motion, hereby

ORDERS as follows:

1. The motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The Court hereby directs the Clerk of Court that, pursuant to the Motion, the following information and exhibits in Baptist’s Motion to Exclude and/or Limit Expert Opinions of Richard G. Langosch, Carol Fox, and J. Craig Stevens shall be kept confidential and restricted from public access:

- a. Exhibit 1, or the Expert Report of Richard G. Langosch;
- b. Exhibit 2, or the Deposition Transcript of Richard G. Langosch;
- c. Exhibit 3, or the Expert Report of Carol Fox;
- d. Exhibit 4, or the Deposition Transcript of Carol Fox;
- e. Exhibit 5, or the Expert Report of J. Craig Stevens and;
- f. Exhibit 6, or the Deposition Transcript of J. Craig Stevens.


3. In accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(4), the Court makes the following determinations:

- a. This case is a civil action related to allegations of fraudulent sales of medical devices.
- b. The grounds for keeping this information confidential is that the exhibits relate, refer, or include information derived from materials the Parties have identified as confidential pursuant to the Protective Order and HIPAA Qualified Protective Order regarding disclosure of confidential materials. Dkt. Nos. 65, 68.
- c. No party names are determined to be confidential.
- d. No progress docket or similar records to document activity in the case is determined to be confidential.
- e. The particular information determined to be confidential is the information specified in Paragraph 2 of this Order, which relates to confidential financial information.
- f. The identification of the persons permitted to view this confidential information filed with the Court, are the Court, court staff, and the Parties.
- g. The Court finds that the (i) degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c), and (ii) no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c).
- h. The Clerk of Court is directed to publish this order in accordance with Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(e)(5).
