**ORDER TO SEAL TRIAL COURT RECORDS DEEMED CONFIDENTIAL PURSUANT TO
FLORIDA RULES OF GENERAL PRACTICE AND JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.420(c)(9)**

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon the joint stipulation and request of the parties, on August 6, 2026, to seal confidential trial court records and presentation of this Order to Seal Trial court Records Deemed Confidential by both the Former Husband, JAMES T. DALY and Former Wife, APRIL DALY, pursuant to Rule 2.420(c)(9) Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration. The parties request entry of this Order to seal the confidential records as listed herein relative to this Dissolution of Marriage case and post-judgment proceedings, and having considered the parties' request, legal authority, and otherwise being fully advised, the Court **GRANTS** the request and finds as follows:

1. Confidentiality of the documents is required to protect the following interests:
 - a. protecting work product and/or attorney client privilege;
 - b. avoid substantial injury to innocent third parties;
 - c. avoid substantial injury to a party by disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in a Dissolution of Marriage Proceeding;

- d. comply with established public policy set forth in the Florida or United States Constitution, Statutes and/or Florida rules or case law; and
 - e. comply with Section 119.0714(1)(i)-0, Fla. Stat.
2. The Court further finds that no less restrictive measure is available to protect these records, and that the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect the interests.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that:

A. The Clerk of the Duval County Circuit Court is hereby directed to seal immediately the following materials related to. this matter and to keep such materials from public access:

1. **All financial affidavits of the parties filed in this matter, including but not limited to: Doc #D16 filed on November 7, 2016; Doc #D270 filed on January 24, 2019, Doc #D324 filed on March 21, 2019; Doc #D425 filed on March 12, 2025; Doc #D457 filed on November 13, 2025; Doc #D428 filed on March 25, 2025; Doc #D494 filed on March 23, 2026; Doc #D504 filed on March 25, 2026; Doc #D595 filed on August 4, 2026; and Doc #D600 filed on August 6, 2026;**
2. **All hearing and trial exhibits, Petitioner's/Former Wife's and Respondent's /Former Husband's, including but not limited to: Exhibits filed on August 22, 2018 at Doc #D191 through and including Doc #D196; Exhibits filed on March 2, 2026 at Doc #D519 through and including Doc #D549; Exhibits filed on March 26, 2026 at Doc #D535 through and including Doc #D548; and Exhibits filed on April 6, 2026 at Doc #D537 through and including Doc #D 538. These exhibits include financial information of the parties and non-parties and other information which discloses private information about the parties and non-parties; and**

3. **Notice of Filings and Depositions Transcripts of Former Wife and Douglas Greene, including but not limited to deposition filed on March 24, 2026 at #D500, and deposition filed on June 26, 2026 at #D576.**

B. It is further **ORDERED** that, any materials sealed pursuant to this Order shall be conditionally disclosed upon the entry of a further order by this Court finding that such opening is necessary for purposes of judicial or governmental accountability or first amendment rights.

C. It is further **ORDERED** that, any materials sealed pursuant to this order may otherwise be disclosed as follows:

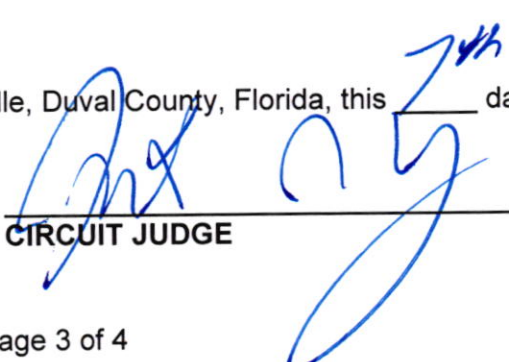
1. to any judge of this Circuit for case-related reasons;
2. to the Chief Judge or his or her designee;
3. to the Husband or his attorneys of record;
4. to the Wife or her attorneys of record;
5. by further order of the Court.

D. It is further **ORDERED** that, within 10 days of the date of this Order, the Clerk shall post a copy of this Order on the bulletin board and the Clerk's website for a period of 30 days to provide public notice.

E. It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby authorized to unseal any materials sealed pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files, or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The Materials shall be resealed immediately upon completion of the filing.

F. It is further **ORDERED** that the requirements of all prior Orders of the Court regarding sealing court records and/or sealing confidential information in court records remain in full effect in addition to this Order.
