AGREED ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS

Administration subsections (vii): comply with established public policy set forth in state and federal statutes and case law.

No party's name is determined to be confidential. (B)

witnesses, and other individuals involved in the prosecution or defense of the litigation.
